

SENSORY CUSHION PATTERN

2.07



DESCRIPTION

This cushion was made from two 40cm squares of fabric, sewn right sides together and stuffed with soft cushion / pillow filler.

Cut 4 pieces per pocket, one for the lining one for each facing side.

Sew right sides together, leaving one end free to turn inside-out.

HANDY HINT

It's easier to sew pockets onto the cushion square before sewing the big cushion squares together and filling.

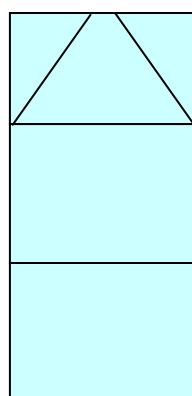
Fabric suggestions: silk, crushed silk, cotton, velvet, felt, fringes and tassels, nylon, satin, chiffon, any bright fabric off cuts gathered from friends and family.
