DESCRIPTION

Provides an immediate alert when a person wearing the wrist band passes a boundary sensor.

People with identified needs wear an ordinary-looking wristwatch that works in conjunction with sensors mounted on doorways and/or driveways.

The watch is comfortable, non-stigmatizing and age-appropriate ensuring the wearer doesn't feel different from their peers.

A driveway sensor is also available; it is solar powered and communicates alarms wirelessly to the facility. It requires no cabling, simplifying installation.

APPLICATIONS

Supports people to freely walk around the residential home, while alerting staff if they leave the main entrance.
