DESCRIPTION

Tile & Pebblebee are two of many Bluetooth tags you can attach, stick or place on keys, handbag, wallet etc. Once attached to the item download the free App available from the Apple Store or Google Play to your android phone or iPhone then you can locate your lost item using the App on your phone.

Common features:

Loud alert speaker, water resistant, community find, lightweight, small in size. Refer to the websites for further information on these devices.

APPLICATIONS

These Bluetooth tags are suitable for carers or people with a mild level of cognitive impairment. People living with dementia have a tendency to misplace items which may cause anxiety when leaving the house.

Carers could assist by using the device to locate items before going out.
