DESCRIPTION

A small magnetic sensor and radio transmitter unit is mounted at the top of the door to be monitored.

When the door is opened a signal is sent to the wireless alarm system receiver/buzzer. This sensor is battery powered and gives a low battery warning.

The toggle switch on the side of the transmitter can be used to turn the unit off if you want to have the door open without the alarm sounding.

APPLICATIONS

Allows the carer to be alerted if a person with dementia leaves the house during the day or night.
