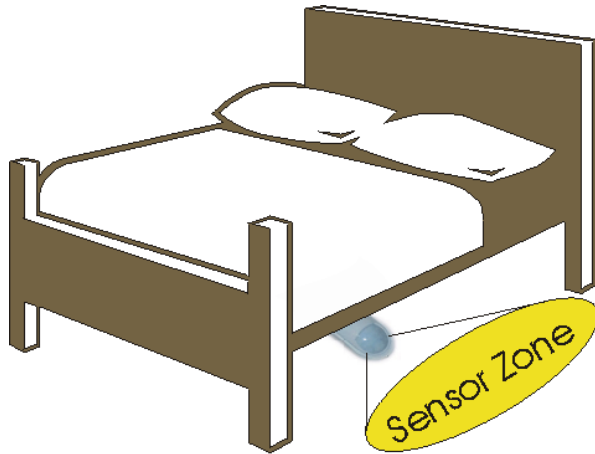

## DESCRIPTION

Positioning the PIR sensor under the bed will allow the monitored person to move about in bed without causing an alarm.

However, as soon as the occupant hangs their feet over the side of the bed they will be visible to the sensor window, and the alarm will be triggered.

Alternatively it may be used for monitoring the space outside the bedroom door, triggering the alarm when the client leaves the room.

When the sensor detects movement a signal is sent to the receiver/buzzer.

## APPLICATIONS

This device allows the carer to be alerted if a person with dementia leaves their bed or bedroom during the day or during the night.

The Receiver Unit is portable and can be plugged into a power point in the carer's room/living room etc.

Receiver Units can be moved about as required.
